Gathering Place, Tulsa's Riverfront Park

Brooke Caviness, P.E. is a Senior Engineer with the City of Tulsa and the project manager for the City for their infrastructure projects associated with Gathering Place, Tulsa's Riverfront Park. Brooke led a guided tour of the park which included discussions about technical and construction challenges the design teams faced, as well as discussion about the extensive coordination required to bring the project to completion as anticipated in September 2018. The total cost for the park, including the City's investment in infrastructure was \$465 million. The design work for the park began in 2011 and the City's infrastructure projects in 2014.
